Section 3: Parent and Player Code of Conduct

We encourage you to root for your team, to play hard and to have fun. However, the NPBA will not tolerate unsportsmanlike behavior or those who violate the rules. Parents, players, coaches, officials, or spectators who violate the code of conduct may be subject to disciplinary action, including suspension, expulsion and exclusion from NPBA participation. We appreciate your cooperation and support.

- All parents and fans are expected to root for their team. The NPBA WILL NOT TOLERATE NEGATIVE REMARKS OR GESTURES made towards the officials, players, coaches, or spectators. Parents and spectators can be called for a technical foul against their team for verbal abuse.
- All players are expected to DO THEIR BEST AT ALL TIMES, always SHOW GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP (win or lose), and AVOID NEGATIVE REMARKS to the officials, players, coaches, and spectators.
- Coaches are expected to control their teams and the parents of the players on their teams at all times. The NPBA is an instructional league and coaches should teach SPORTSMANSHIP, EFFORT, SKILLS IMPROVEMENT, and TEAMWORK over winning and individual accolades.
- No official, player, coach, or spectator shall lay a hand upon, push, shove, strike, threaten, verbally abuse, or otherwise endanger the safety of any other official, player, coach, or spectator. In addition to game forfeiture, violators may be banned from future NPBA participation.
